

Full Day Macau Excursion

Pick up from hotel approx. 0900 and transfer to pier for ferry to Macau. Upon arrival, sightseeing tour begins with World Heritages including Temple of A-Ma & Ruins of St. Paul's.

Temple of A-Ma was built 400 years ago in homage to a girl who saved a seamen's life. Macau was later named by the Portuguese settlers in mid-16th Century. This temple has become a World Heritage in 2005

Ruins of St. Paul's are a magnificent stone facade and grand staircase remains of the iconic Church of St. Paul's. The church was built in 1602 next to the Jesuit College of St. Paul's, the first Western college in Asia where missionaries studied Chinese before serving at the Ming Court in Beijing as astronomers and mathematicians.

Visit the Macau Museum located at the Monte Fort facing St. Paul's Ruins will let you know more about the history of Macau, a place where the East and West have so peculiarly learnt how to meet and to live side by side along the centuries.

From the Macau Tower, you can gaze out over Taipa and Coloane from the breathtaking 223M above ground. Look for Macau's landmarks and historical sites, or try to spot Hong Kong's outlying Islands.

Besides the heritages, Macau is famous with new deluxe hotels which were built recently, such as The Venetian and MGM Grand.

The tour fare includes :

- Transfer and tour in private vehicle with English speaking guide
- Round trip Macau ferry ticket (economy class)
- Entrance ticket for Macau Tower
- Buffet lunch at Café Deco in The Venetian
